SCSP

- Coordinated 9,070 demonstrations under SCSP, in collaboration with ANGRAU (100), AU (Annamalai University) (200), BHU (150), CSKHP (300), Ghandigram Rural Institute (100), KAU (200), ICAR-KVKs (400), MSSRF (450), MYRADA (200), PAJANCOA & RI (900), PJTAU (100), TNAU (250) and others viz., AICRIP centers and NGOs in 2024-25.
- Under ICAR-IIRR-SCSP, 5,000 Soil testing kits and 10,000 Soil Health cards were distributed to SC Farmers of Khammam, Nalgonda, Vikarabad (pargi), Manchiryal, Wanaparthy, Hogulamba Gadwal and Narayanapeta, districts of Telangana. Raichur and Gudimitkal districts of Karnataka and Pune district of Maharashtra and Coimbatore and Erode districts of Tamilnadu.
- Other inputs such as Paddy seed, Drying sheets, Sprayers, Fertilizers, Herbicides, Fungicides, insecticides, Pheromone traps and lures, Bio control agents, were distributed to the SC beneficiaries of Seven states (Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana and Puducherry).

- ICAR-Indian Institute of Rice Research coordinated 3470 demonstrations under the Tribal Sub Plan (TSP), in collaboration with ANGRAU, BAU, CAU, ICAR-KVKs, IGKV, MSSRF, PAJANCOA & RI, PJTSAU, SKUAST, TNAU,, AICRIP centers in 2024-25.
- The total allotted budges of Rs.52 lakhs was effectively spent. Under ICAR-IIRR-TSP, 500 Soil testing kits were distributed to Tribal Farmers of Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and West Bengal.
- Paddy seed, tarpaulin sheets, Sprayers, Fertilizers, Pesticides, Water storage barrel, Neem oil, Zinc Sulfate, Pheromone traps, Mycorrhiza (VAM), Trichoderma etc. were distributed to the ST beneficiaries of Nine states (Andhra Pradesh (400), Assam (200), Chhattisgarh (200), Jharkhand (200), Jammu & Kashmir (400), Kerala (200), Manipur (200), Odisha (400) and Tamil Nadu (200), and Puducherry (350).
